- ◆ 46% less likely to start using drugs

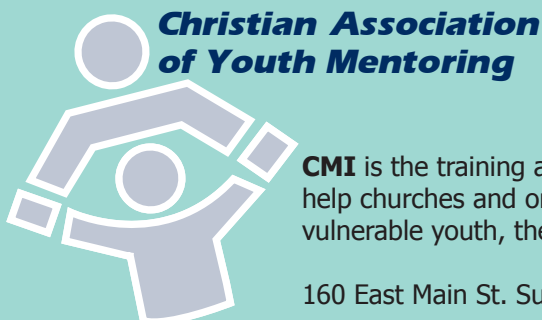
